One of the positive sides of climate change is that the Spiti Valley is wetter and warmer in summer and it is now possible to grow apple trees. Many farmers have created orchards of twenty to thirty trees and they are thriving. To start with, there were no fences around their orchards - the village children love to pick apples (a new and healthy treat for them) but not good for the farmer! Now the orchards have high fences with strong gates!

Our Trustees thought that if we could provide each household with two apple trees the children could "pick their own" and the farmers would be left with their apples to harvest and sell. Apples are rich in vitamin C and would be a welcome treat for young children. There are over one thousand households in the Valley.
